RESOLUTION NO. 24

Authorizing the adjustment of the 1989-90 fiscal year Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission budget to appropriate sufficient funds for the initial hardware and software purchase of computers at the Oregon Convention Center.

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. That the Computer RFP is currently being developed and finalized.

2. That bids are not scheduled to be awarded, nor will a contract be signed, before the end of the 1988-89 fiscal year.

3. That it is projected \$205,000 will be required for hardware and software during the 1989-90 fiscal year.

4. That the 1989-90 MERC budget is currently in process.

5. That it is necessary to increase Revenue line item #299000, Fund Balance, from \$1,400,000 to \$1,455,000; and Capital Outlay line item #571400, Purchase Equipment and Vehicles, from \$150,000 to \$205,000.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Commission authorizes adjustment of the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission budget to appropriate sufficient funds for the initial hardware and software purchase of computers at the Oregon Convention Center.
