

METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 27

Approving a Request for Proposals for Concessions and Catering Management for the Oregon Convention Center (operated by Metro ERC) and Memorial Coliseum Complex and Civic Stadium (operated by the ERC).

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. That the construction of the Oregon Convention Center is well underway.
2. That the Metro ERC wishes to contract concessions and catering management services.
3. That the current ERC contract with Ogden Allied Leisure Services for concessions and catering is expiring and has been extended to September 30, 1989.
4. That jointly the Commissions desire to request concessions and catering proposals for the Oregon Convention Center (operated by Metro ERC) and Memorial Coliseum Complex and Civic Stadium (operated by the ERC) as consolidated facilities with a single proposer.
5. That a Selection Committee comprised of members representing both the Exposition-Recreation Commission and Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission has been appointed and has prepared the concessions and catering management request for proposals.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Commission approves the Request for Proposals for concessions and catering management by a single proposer for operation of the Oregon Convention Center (operated by Metro ERC) and Memorial Coliseum Complex and Civic Stadium (operated by the ERC).
