

METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 30

Approving a four percent (4%) adjustment to base salaries of Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission Oregon Convention Center non-represented employees, retroactive from July 1, 1989, or hire date, whichever is later.

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. That on June 14, 1989, the Exposition-Recreation Commission granted a 4% salary adjustment for non-represented employees at City facilities, effective July 1, 1989.


2. That staff recommends a four percent (4%) adjustment for Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission Oregon Convention Center non-represented employees retroactive from July 1, 1989, in order to unify the MERC and ERC salary compensation plans.

3. That a budgetary transfer is not necessary to cover wage adjustments for non-represented employees, as adequate funds exist in the FY 1989-90 Budget.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Commission approves a four percent (4%) adjustment to base salaries of Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission Oregon Convention Center non-represented employees, retroactive from July 1, 1989, or hire date, whichever is later.
