

METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 42

Authorizing the General Manager to enter into contract negotiations with the Portland/Oregon Visitors Association to develop a three (3) year agreement for the national sales and marketing of the Oregon Convention Center for the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission.

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. The Oregon Convention Center was developed and constructed to serve as a primary meeting facility to attract national and regional events to Portland.
2. The Portland/Oregon Visitors Association was the only respondent to the Request for Qualifications to identify firms or individuals capable of providing the requested national sales and marketing effort necessary to adequately promote the Oregon Convention Center.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission hereby authorizes the General Manager to enter into contract negotiations with the Portland/Oregon Visitors Association.
