RESOLUTION NO. 58


Approving a request for proposals for a salary compensation study for non-represented employees of the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission (Metro ERC), a division of the Metropolitan Service District.

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:


1. That consolidation of City and Metro facilities will be completed by July 1, 1990.
2. That the Commission expressed a desire to see the results of a professional salary compensation study for non-represented employees at their February 14, 1990, meeting.
3. That a selection committee comprised of Commissioners Ares and Middleton has been appointed and a request for proposals has been prepared.
4. That a consolidated organizational structure has been completed.
5. That a professional salary compensation study has not been conducted for non-represented employees.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Commission approves a request for proposals for a salary compensation study for non-represented employees of the Commission. RFP shall be approved by the Selection Committee.
