

METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 89

Authorizing the Chairman and General Manager to execute, on behalf of the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission, an Addendum to the Theatrical Employees Union, Local B-20, International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees and Moving Picture Operators of the United States and Canada (Union), which extends all of the terms and conditions of the existing Exposition-Recreation Commission contract with IATSE Local B-20 to apply to admission control employees working in the Oregon Convention Center.


The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. That the Commission on July 11, 1990, approved Resolution No. 82, which authorized the Chairman and General Manager to execute, on behalf of the Commission, an agreement with IATSE Local B-20, which modified and extended an existing collective bargaining agreement between the Commission (for the Coliseum, Stadium, and PCPA) and the Union, covering a three year period from July 1, 1990, through June 30, 1993.
2. That the Oregon Convention Center has the same requirements for admission labor (ticket sellers, gate attendants, head gate attendants, ushers, and head ushers) as does the Coliseum for conventions and trade shows.
3. That it is prudent and in the best interest of the public to amend the existing contract with IATSE Local B-20 so that all the terms and conditions of this contract shall apply to the admission control employees working in the Oregon Convention Center.
4. That the Metro Service District labor attorney, Commission staff, and representatives of the Union have negotiated an addendum to the existing agreement so that all the terms and conditions of this contract shall apply to admission control employees working in the Oregon Convention Center.
5. That this amendment has been ratified by the Union and that the job classifications covered by this Addendum are those specified in Article 1.1 of the aforementioned B-20 contract dated July 6, 1990, and in effect until July 1, 1993.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the proposed Addendum to the existing Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission contract with IATSE Local B-20, whereby all the terms and conditions shall apply to admission control employees working in the Oregon Convention Center, is hereby approved, and the Chair and General Manager are authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Commission.



THIS ADDENDUM is entered into between the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission and Local B-20, Theatrical Stage Employees of the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees and Moving Picture Operators of the United States and Canada. The Parties hereby agree that all of the terms and conditions of the existing Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission contract with IATSE Local B-20 shall apply to admission control employees working in the Oregon Convention Center, including the Employer's right and responsibility to manage and schedule employees at the Oregon Convention Center as stated in Sections 4 and 8. The job classifications covered by this Addendum are those specified in Article 1.1 of the aforementioned B-20 contract dated 7-6-90 and in effect until July 1, 1993.
