The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:


1. That a Commission policy on special permit parking is necessary to provide for parking for the Commissioners and the five major metropolitan jurisdictions.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Commission adopts the attached Policy on Special Permit Parking.

Metro E-R Commission Policy on Special Permit Parking

Policy

Metro E-R Commissioners will be provided specially identified parking spaces and permits for the Memorial Coliseum and the Oregon Convention Center. Additionally, permits will be provided to the five major metropolitan jurisdictions as outlined in the procedures adopted by the Commission.

Procedure

- A. Metro E-R Commissioners: Each Commissioner will receive a specially identified parking space adjacent to the Memorial Coliseum and Oregon Convention Center. A special permit will be issued and must be displayed in the window or on the dashboard. This will enable staff to monitor and control these parking areas.
- B. Representing Jurisdictions:

Memorial Coliseum Complex: The parking spaces for officials will be marked "Reserved" and designated (stenciled) with the individual's parking permit number. (No names or jurisdiction will be used.) The parking permit must be displayed in the window or on the dash of the vehicle. By numbering the reserved parking space it will allow the official more flexibility of use but if the permit is not displayed there is risk of ticketing or towing.

1. City of Portland - 2 permits
2. Metropolitan Service District - 2 permits
3. Multnomah County - 1 permit
4. Clackamas County - 1 permit
5. Washington County - 1 permit

Oregon Convention Center: The parking permits issued to officials as stated above will be honored at the Oregon Convention Center parking facility as available and parking will be on an open basis.
