Background

MERC has been given the task of operating the Portland Exposition Center by METRO effective January 01, 1994. Multnomah County had a Petty Cash fund of \$600.00 at the Expo Center and those funds were returned to the county. These funds need to be replaced in order to maintain and provide for emergency and small operational expenditures. These new funds will be maintained in accordance with MERC policies for Petty Cash funds.

Budget Impact

Approximately \$2,400 for the remainder of FY94.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that two Petty Cash funds of \$200.00 be established; one for General and Administrative use and the other for Operations use.
