BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission directs staff and Fine Host Corporation to implement recommended concession menu for Civic Stadium effective June 15, 1995 to March 31, 1996.

MERC STAFF REPORT

Agenda Item/Issue: Civic Stadium Concession Menu Pricing June 1995 - May 1996

DATE: June 14, 1995

Background and Analysis: Recently, MERC conducted an RFP process to select a concessionaire to manage food and beverage service at Civic Stadium and Expo Center which resulted in Fine Host Corporation being chosen as the concessionaire for these two facilities. Staff has met with Fine Host Stadium/Expo General Manager, Chris Alaimo, to review menu items. The goal in selecting items and pricing them was to broaden the menu selections, keeping the facility demographics in mind, and to price items to generate a reasonable profit, yet be family affordable. The majority of the current menu prices remain unchanged, with a few price increases to meet production costs and a few price reductions to be market sensitive. New items are aimed at serving the child market and initiating in-seat service for the Rockies box seat holders. As a note, there have been no price increases, with the exception of alcohol, since 1992.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: Budget impact should be neutral in terms of price increases. However, better management of food/beverage service and additional points of sale should result in a 7 to 10 percent increase in gross revenues.

Discussions with Commission Liaisons and/or User Groups: Both Liaison Commissioners Middleton and Foster have expressed interest in Civic Stadium pricing remaining family affordable, and staff has tried to reflect that in this pricing structure. Commissioner Middleton was able to attend the "VIP taste testing" hosted by the Rockies and Fine Host so was able to get a first-hand look and taste at products which will be offered. Fine Host staff has been working very closely with Portland Rockies management to develop menus appropriate to their needs.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Staff recommends approval of the concessions menu to be effective June 15 1995 - May 31, 1996, allowing for review and adjustment, if needed, in 12 months.
