METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 95-34

Authorizing the MERC General Manager to execute one-year extensions to Employers Overload, Beginright Inc., and St. Vincent DePaul Rehabilitation Services for light industrial labor services. Bill rates to be adjusted to reflect the Consumer Price Index for Portland, Oregon as last updated through December 1994 and published in February 1995. Contracts expire June 30, 1995.

The Metropolitan Exposition Recreation Commission finds:

1. That the current contracts for temporary personnel services expire June 30, 1995 with the following companies:

- 2. That the use of temporary industrial labor has been economically advantage to the operation of the Portland Exposition Center, Civic Stadium, Portland Center for the Performing Arts and the Oregon Convention Center.
- 3. That the Commission desires to continue to utilize temporary personnel services at Civic Stadium, PCPA, Expo Center and the Oregon Convention Center.
- 4. That the Commission should exercise it's option to extend the current contracts to June 30, 1996.
- 5. That a hourly rate increase of no more than 2.9% should be added to the contracts for services to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for Portland, Oregon as last updated through December 1994 and published in February 1995.
- 6. That \$159,000 is budgeted in the 1995/96 fiscal year budget for these services.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Metropolitan Exposition Recreation Commission's General Manager is authorized to execute, on the behalf of the Commission, an extension to the current contracts for the period July 1,1995 through June 30, 1996 for temporary personnel services, in conformance with this resolution.

Background and Analysis:

In August of 1994, the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission passed Resolution #94-45 authorizing the General Manager to enter into temporary personnel service agreements with Employers Overload, Beginright, Inc., and St. Vincent DePaul Rehabilitation Services. Two were selected as a result of the IFB process which included 24 prospective bidders. St. Vincent DePaul is exempted from Public Bid Process per House Bill #3075 and had to be included. These agreements provide for 2 one-year renewal options with rates to be adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for Portland, Oregon. Staff have utilized personnel from all three services and are satisfied with their performance in providing light industrial temporary personnel.

Fiscal Impact:

1995-96 proposed budget amount for temporary personnel at MERC facilities is \$159,000.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approve a one year extension to Employers Overload, Beginright, Inc., and St. Vincent DePaul Rehabilitation Services, Inc., for a period to commence July 1, 1995 and end June 30, 1996, with rates adjusted no more than 2.9% to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for Portland, Oregon as updated through December 1994 and published February 1995.
