Recognizing the outstanding inaugural season of Portland's Broadway Theater Season presented by the Portland Opera/Jujamcyn Productions organization

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

- 1. The Portland Opera and Jujamcyn Productions brought together local and national marketing resources to create and deliver a subscription season that was exciting, of the highest quality, and was offered in conjunction with the megahit "Miss Saigon".
- 2. In its inaugural year, Portland's Broadway Theatre Season subscription sales and total revenue generation exceeded all expectations, and drew national attention to the Portland market. Attendance for the four-show subscription series reached an astounding 95% of capacity.
- 3. Supplementing the original subscription series, the Portland Opera and Jujamcyn Productions brought add-on events including 16 performances of "Angels in America" in the Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall, attracting both outstanding attendance and critical acclaim.
- 4. The successful relationship with the Portland Opera/Jujamcyn Productions organization has contributed significantly to the stabilization of finances for the Portland Center for the Performing Arts, and will assist in establishing a more predictable stream of earned revenue in the future.
