

METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

Resolution No. 96-35

For the purpose of directing staff to proceed with one-year extensions to the two Broadway Series at the Portland Center for the Performing Arts.

Whereas, the Commission has contracts with Dan Bean Presents and Portland Opera/Jujamcyn for the presentation of Broadway productions at the Portland Center for the Performing Arts (PCPA); and

Whereas, Commission has been considering the future of such presentations at the PCPA; and

Whereas, the Commission has determined that it will be in the public interest to extend each of these contracts for an additional year;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

1. That Commission staff is directed to negotiate with each of the Commission's Broadway Presenters for a one-year extension of their current agreements.

2. That any tentative agreements reached by staff with the Commission's Broadway presenters shall be brought back to the Commission and shall be subject to final approval by formal vote of the Commission.

3. That upon expiration of any one-year extensions which are approved, it is the current sense of the Commission that it may consider a competition for future Broadway presentations at the PCPA. This expression of the current sense of the Commission is not intended to prevent or limit the Commission from taking any actions at any future time that it deems to be in the public interest.
