<u>Background:</u> The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approved rental rates for the Portland Metropolitan Exposition Center in April 1995. During the intervening time period, operational costs have risen and with the recent expansion, operational costs and associated requirements will increase accordingly. In order to compensate for these increases, it is necessary to adjust rental rates.

Staff conducted a telephone survey of seven "comparable" facilities and determined that the proposed rates remain competitive for exposition space and the services furnished.

Staff also provided the rental rates to the Expo Advisory Committee for comment and the rates were approved as proposed.

<u>Fiscal Impact:</u> The proposed rates relfect an average increase of approximately 4% for individual hall rental and 11% for hall combinations.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed FY 1997-98 Facility Rental Rates for the Portland Metropolitan Exposition Center.
