<u>Background:</u> In May 1995, the Commission awarded a management agreement to Fine Host Corporation/S. Brooks and Associates, Inc., a Joint Venture, to provide concession and catering services to the Portland Metropolitan Exposition Center and Civic Stadium beginning July 1, 1995.

Since the award resulted in authorizing a service provider new to the Expo Center, it is necessary to establish an initial concession menu and pricing schedule, see attached, which is compatible with the needs of the Expo Center's food and beverage consumers in addition to meeting the requirements of the management agreement.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: The proposed concession menu and pricing schedule was designed to address pricing sensitivity, the need for an expanded menu selection in addition to accommodating issues of excise tax and the management agreement structure.

It is highly speculative to estimate the fiscal impact of this proposed schedule; however, the pricing is not greatly dissimilar to historical price practice at the Expo and provides for increased sales through an expanded selection of product. It is reasonable to anticipate, therefore, that the fiscal impact will, at minimum, meet the previous year's results.

Staff will closely monitor the results of the proposed schedule and, if deemed appropriate or necessary, will recommend adjustments for the Commissions review and approval.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed concession menu and pricing schedule.
