Background Analysis:

With the implementation of the Oregon Convention Center (OCC) expansion program and the subsequent increase in construction related activities it is essential to add a Construction Coordinator to provide expertise in overseeing and/or managing various aspects of this program.

This position is responsible for providing construction coordination including supervision and inspection services between the OCC Expansion Project Team and contractors operating on the OCC Expansion project; maintains internal record-keeping systems; provides design and project management recommendation; and performs administrative services.

The duties assigned to this position warrant a new classification title and salary range. The proposed new classification is Construction Coordinator and the recommended salary range is 053. This new classification and the defined job duties have been reviewed and approved by the General Manager and Human Resources.

Fiscal Impact:

Fiscal impact does not apply at this time. The increase will be covered by the 2000-2001 budget.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Metropolitan Exposition Recreation Commission approve the creation of the Construction Coordinator to handle the responsibilities as outlined in the Background Analysis.
