RESOLUTION NO. 99-20

Approving an increase to FY 1999-00, FY 2000-01 and FY 2001-02 Exhibit Hall, Ballrooms, Twin Tower Plus Package and some Meeting Room rental rates for the Oregon Convention Center effective July 1, 1999.

The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission finds:

1. That there is a need to raise rental rates at the Oregon convention Center to increase operating revenues and accomplish the budgetary goals set by the MERC Commission.

2. That a survey has been conducted of similar facilities in competitive markets as well as a solicitation of comments from users regarding the proposed rental rates to help the Convention Center position its rate structure to remain competitive and to maintain the first class quality of facilities and services.

3. That the Commission has the authority to set rental rates for its facilities based upon competition, facility usage and operational requirements.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approves the increased rental rates for the Oregon Convention Center Ballrooms, Exhibit Halls, Twin Tower Plus Package and certain Meeting Rooms, attached as Exhibit A, to be effective July 1, 1999.

Background Analysis: The Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approved FY 1999-00, FY 2000-01 and FY 2001-02 rental rates for the Oregon Convention Center on March 11, 1998 with Resolution No. 98-11.

Since that time, several developments have resulted in staff reviewing these approved rates and recommending a change to them for the next three years.

- The Oregon Convention Center expansion project has been approved to move forward beginning April of 2000. Staff is concerned about raising rental rates during construction as well as the costs for event management, client problems, no parking revenue and other unbudgeted costs that may be associated with expansion. Staff has identified some of these costs – others are unknown.
- 2) At the direction of the Commission Budget Committee and approval of the Oregon Convention Center budget by the full MERC Commission, staff was instructed to find ways to improve the operating revenue as well as keep the fund balance as solid as possible through the next few years. Staff made expenditure cuts and added events to the catering roles to increase revenues and explained to both the MERC Budget Committee and the full MERC Commission that increasing rental rates and parking charges would also be a part of this solution. Staff recommended an increased revenue projection for the 1999-00 budget with the understanding that rental rates would need to be increased.

Staff is recommending the acceleration of approved rates for FY 1999-00, FY 200-01 and FY 2001-02 at this time to accomplish the revenue wishes of the Commission and not raise rates during the two-year OCC expansion project. By raising the rates now, the desired result of both the Commission and staff is achieved.

Surveys have been conducted by staff to determine the competitiveness of OCC rates to other facilities throughout the country and, specifically, the West. These responses were compiled and staff has concluded that the rates at the Oregon Convention Center are very competitive as they relate to our ability to continue to attract convention and trade show business.

The OCC Advisory Committee at two separate meetings has reviewed the rates and no major concerns have been registered.

Fiscal Impact: The increase in certain rental rates will result in an increase of an estimated \$94,800 in FY 1999-00.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Staff recommends that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approves the attached increased rental rates for the Oregon Convention Center Ballrooms, Exhibit Halls, Twin Towers Plus Package and certain meeting rooms effective July 1, 1999.
