Resolution No. 02-33

For the Purpose of revising Change Order #2 to GMP Contract 922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion, and authorizing the MERC General Manager to execute Change Order #2 (REVISED) on behalf of the Commission.

WHEREAS, the Commission previously approved via Resolution #02-14 on April 24, 2002, Change Order #2 to the contract with Hoffman Construction Company for inclusion of 11 alternates of work in the existing building as part of the Oregon Convention Center Expansion, and for increasing the GMP maximum total to \$102,070,981; and,

WHEREAS, funds totaling \$3,570,981 have been previously established and approved within the OCC CIP account for the estimated costs identified in Change Order #2; and

WHEREAS, Change Order #2 allowed for future revisions based on final scope and pricing; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work identified within Change Order #2 has been reassessed by the Oregon Convention Center Director based on the available funding within Change Order #2 and confirmed by competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Change Order #2 (REVISED) reallocates the available funds previously established and incorporates the change of scope work items as directed by the Oregon Convention Center Director without additional costs, and

WHEREAS, the OCC Expansion Team recommends that the Commission approve these changes to the GMP scope of work through Change Order #2 (REVISED); and

WHEREAS, the OCC Expansion Advisory Committee has reviewed and recommends Change Order #2 (REVISED) in a form substantially similar to Exhibit A, to the contract with Hoffman Construction Company to document these changes to the GMP contract,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approves revising Change Order #2 to Change Order #2 (REVISED) to MERC contract #922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion, in a form substantially similar to Exhibit A, for no additional cost; and
- 2. That the MERC General Manager is authorized to execute GMP Change Order #2 (REVISED) on behalf of the Commission.

Background/Analysis:

MERC Commission Resolution 01-02 dated January 17, 2001 established the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract # 922771 for \$98.5 million with Hoffman Construction Company for the construction of the Oregon Convention Center Expansion. Change Order #1, approved via MERC Commission Resolution #2-13, dated April 24, 2002 incorporated (11) work alternates to the contract without an increase in the GMP maximum price, utilizing savings identified within the GMP.

Change Order #2, approved via MERC Commission Resolution #02-14 also dated April 24, 2002, authorized the increase of the GMP by \$3,570,981 to a total maximum price of \$102,070,981 for the incorporation of an additional (11) alternates to the scope of the Project. Funding for these alternates was authorized through the OCC CIP account in order to incorporate CIP work for the existing building to be completed as requested by the Director of the Oregon Convention Center.

Change Order #2 established allowances for the majority of the work to be completed under this Change Order, based on estimated costs for the work. Alternates #21, #39, and #25 were bid and costs were substantiated. The Change Order #2 (REVISED) defined below is the adjustment required based on actual bids and negotiation of the work to be completed.

In addition, the OCC Director has defined reallocation of costs of the CIP program to fund critical work as determined at this point of the Project. The adjustments defined below incorporate the OCC Director's established priorities for completion of work for the Oregon Convention Center.

Issue: Based on actual bids, adjustments have been required in order to fund the scope of work desired by the Oregon Convention Center Director. The following is a detailed list of the adjustments requested for Change Order #2:

<u>Alt #4 – Exterior Signage, Alt #25 – Interior Signage, Alt #26 – Interior Electronic Signage, Alt.</u> <u>#27 – Exterior Electronic Signage</u>. Original Budget - \$710,000 total. Revised Budget -\$1,020,000 total. The original budget established for this signage totaled \$710,000, including interior electronic signage. This budget which was established two years ago did not account for the many adjustments that have been required with the signage. This includes extensive investment in additional signage for the exterior to meet the City of Portland conditions and longterm desires by the OCC. Additional impacts include the upgrade of the existing signage to a higher level to match the design-approved existing building. Based on actual bids, the OCC Director has determined that the funding of the sign package as bid is critical and has transferred costs in the amount of \$1,020,000. This revised budget also withdraws the funding for interior electronic signage at this time.

<u>Alt. #15 – Upgrade Existing AV</u>. Original Budget - \$600,000. Revised Budget – \$0. Bids were received for upgrading the existing AV system. Based on an increased scope and receipt of only one bid, bids for the upgrading of the existing AV system were rejected. It was determined that the funds originally budgeted for the upgrade of the AV system should be transferred to pay for increases in the signage and concessions area, per the priority of the OCC Director.

<u>Alt. #20 – Remodel Existing Operations</u>. Original Budget - \$600,000. Revised Budget - \$0. With the increases required for the signage and the concessions, funding sources were reallocated and prioritized to pay for the signage and the concessions. The upgrade of the existing Operations area will be put on hold until alternative funding sources can be established.

<u>Alt #21/39 -- Replace Existing Carpeting</u>. Original Budget - \$1,010,981. Revised Budget - \$1,150,000. Costs have increased to pay for an additional superintendent to coordinate the work for the interior carpet replacement. With the complex schedule required for the installation of this carpet and the limited amount of days within which the carpet must be installed, the Project Team agreed to fund the additional supervision to coordinate the carpet installation without impacting the operations of the existing Convention Center.

<u>Alt #22 – Walcovering Replacement in Existing</u>. Original Budget - \$0. Revised Budget - \$100,981. This item was not originally identified in Change Order #2 in April 2002 based on lack of funding at that time. However, it was requested in the Summer of 2002 by the Oregon Convention Center Director to replace the wallcovering in the existing building based on its deterioration and its conflict with the Expansion wall finishes. With the receipt of bids, it was determined that the value was competitively bid for this work, and it was cost-effective to make the replacement at this time along with the carpet. The Convention Center Director has determined that CIP funds should be reallocated for this item. This cost is being funded by the deletion of funding for the AV system and Operations remodeling.

<u>Alt #28 – Existing Kitchen Remodel</u>. Original Budget - \$175,000. Revised Budget - \$325,000. The original budget established a year ago only addressed the dishwasher area. Through planning and coordination with the OCC Director, it's been determined that additional work is required to offset staff and make room for the new dishwasher. This includes the remodel of the bunker area to relocate the beverage area, and the remodel of the current beverage area to increase the area available for the dishwasher. Construction costs for this work has been competitively bid and an allowance of \$325,000 has been established. This cost is for construction only; it does not include the cost for the dishwasher which is being funded by an alternative source.

<u>Alt. #29 – Replace Fire Alarm Annunciation in Existing</u>. Original Budget - \$400,000. Revised Budget - \$275,000. The original budget had been projected at \$400,000. Actual bids has reduced this cost. The revised contracted amount will be \$275,000. The savings will be used to offset additional costs for signage and concessions.

<u>Commissioning Services.</u> Original Budget - \$75,000. Revised Budget - \$0. The Commissioning services, at the cost of \$75,000 has been transferred to Change Order #3. This is to provide a clean audit trail for the Commissioning services that are being utilized for the entire Project. Therefore, it was determined that the funding should be separated and removed from Change Order #2 which has been funded by CIP funds for work in the existing building.

<u>Alt #13 – Concessions TI</u>. Original Budget - \$0. Revised Budget - \$700,000. The OCC Director has re-prioritized the CIP funding to include the concessions area. A budget of \$700,000 has been established to complete the coordination and construction of the concessions TI. This includes construction, and mechanical and electrical costs. Equipment and cabinetry will be funded by an alternative source for installation into the Concessions TI.

Fiscal Impact:

Although funds are reallocated and some scope of work redefined, the total cost of Change Order #2 (REVISED) has not altered the amount of the original Change Order #2 which was established at \$3,570,981. Change Order #2 (REVISED) is the same total, therefore there is no financial impact to the Project.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission:

- Approve that Change Order #2 dated April 2002 be revised to Change Order #2 (REVISED) to MERC GMP contract 922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion Project for adjustments in the Scope of Work in the existing building as defined in this Staff Report and requested by the Oregon Convention Center Director, and
- 2. That the MERC Commission approves the redistribution of the \$3,570,981 CIP funds previously established for work in the existing building within the original Change Order #2 so as to fund the Scope of Work as re-defined in Change Order #2 (REVISED), and
- 3. That the MERC Commission further authorizes the MERC General Manager to execute Change Order #2 (REVISED) to the GMP contract on behalf of the Commission following established signature authority protocol.
