#### METROPOLITAN EXPOSITION-RECREATION COMMISSION

#### **Resolution No. 03-03**

**For the Purpose of** approving Change Order #4 for GMP Contract 922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion, and authorizing the MERC General Manager to execute GMP Change Order #4 on behalf of the Commission.

WHEREAS, additional design impacts and modifications have created cost impacts to the GMP and the OCC Expansion Project and Design Teams have directed Hoffman Construction Company to complete the necessary construction work to meet code and life safety requirements and provided operational systems; and,

WHEREAS the OCC Director has placed on temporary "hold" status three of the alternates identified in Change Order #2(REVISED) for a total of \$1,042,500 so as not to increase the GMP for the costs of the additional design modification impacts that are required; and,

WHEREAS funds are available within the OCC Operating Fund to transfer \$1,042,500 to the Expansion Construction Fund to finance the additional design modification impacts, and

WHEREAS, resolution and recovery of the costs of the design modification impacts is currently underway between the OCC Expansion Project Team and the design team for the impacts, and those funds will be returned to the OCC Operating Fund; and

WHEREAS, the OCC Expansion Team recommends approval of Change Order #4 for the purpose of incorporating the necessary change of scope work identified above into the GMP Contract #922771 with Hoffman Construction, without an increase to the Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$103,171,481; and

WHEREAS, the OCC Director requested that CIP funds be used to fund the painting of wall covering for the existing building to match the interior walls of public spaces for the Expansion, and

WHEREAS, the OCC Expansion Advisory Committee has been advised of the changes by the Design Team and the recommendation by the OCC Expansion Project Team to temporarily utilize funds put on hold, pending transferring of funds from negotiations with the Design Team, through the use of Change Order #4 to the GMP contract with Hoffman Construction Company for incorporation of the change of scope work to the GMP contract without an increase in the total maximum cost,

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#### **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. That the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission approves Change Order #4, in a form substantially similar to Exhibit A, to Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) MERC contract #922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion to include changes in scope of work as defined in Change Order #4, without increase to the Guaranteed Maximum Price which remains at \$103,171,481, and
- 2. That the MERC Commission approves the reallocation and transfer of \$1,042,500 from the OCC Operating Fund to the OCC Construction Fund for the purpose of financing the scope of work defined in Change Order #4, until the funds to compete the work are recovered from negotiations with the Design Team, and
- 3. That the MERC Commission approves the reallocation of 2002-03 CIP funds to fund the painting of wall covering in the existing building, and
- 4. That the MERC General Manager is authorized to execute GMP Change Order #4 on behalf of the Commission.

#### MERC STAFF REPORT

**Agenda Item:** Approval of Change Order #4 to the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) MERC Contract #922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion.

#### **Background/Analysis:**

MERC Commission Resolution 01-02 dated January 17, 2001 established the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract # 922771 for \$98.5 million with Hoffman Construction Company, Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) for the construction of the Oregon Convention Center Expansion. Change Order #1, approved via MERC Commission Resolution #2-13, dated April 24, 2002 incorporated (11) work alternates to the contract without an increase in the GMP maximum price, utilizing savings identified within the GMP.

Change Order #2 was first approved via MERC Commission Resolution #02-14, also dated April 24, 2002, authorizing the increase of the GMP by \$3,570,981 to a total maximum price of \$102,070,981. Funded by the OCC CIP account, it incorporated an additional (11) alternates for work in the existing building to be completed as requested by the Director of the Oregon Convention Center. Change Order #2 (REVISED) was subsequently approved via MERC Commission Resolution #02-33 dated 10/23/02, which reallocated the CIP funding for Expansion work to be completed in the existing building.

Change Order #3, approved via MERC Commission Resolution #02-34, dated 10/23/02 increased the GMP \$1,100,500 to a maximum total of \$103,171,481. Change Order #3 identified impacts to the GMP based on issues not defined in construction documents. Funding for Change Order #3 was provided through a reallocation of funds from the Owner's "soft costs" to the GMP.

**Issue:** The Design Team has directed the CM/GC to make changes to work already constructed and construct additional features for the Expansion. The additional work had to be completed in order to construct the building to meet code and life safety requirements, so that the building functions as intended by design, and to provide the features established by the original design criteria. The Expansion Team and the OCC Expansion Advisory Committee have agreed that that the work must be completed as defined in Change Order #4 since this work was not incorporated into the original GMP.

The Expansion Team is negotiating with the Design Team to provide a plan for recovery of these additional costs for the design conflicts and work not identified in the contract documents. The Expansion Team has defined to the Design Team the additional work added to the GMP for which MERC is seeking funding reimbursement. However, because this work must be completed now and the settlement for this issue is still pending, a funding transfer is required to fund the impacts being addressed by Change Order 4.

<u>**Proposed Solution:**</u> The Expansion Team proposes that GMP Change Order #4 be approved to provide a funding transfer until settlement can be negotiated with the Design Team and transferred into the project.

Change Order #4 is a mechanism to provide a transfer of funds from the OCC Operating Fund to the OCC Construction fund to finance the critical life safety work that must be completed for the Project. So as not to increase the GMP, the OCC Director has put on temporary "hold" three alternates: the completion of Concessions (\$600,000), existing interior signage (\$270,000), and existing exterior electronic digital signage replacement along Holladay and MLK north (\$172,500) for a total of \$1,042,500.00. Once settlement is reached with the Design Team the concessions, existing interior signage, and exterior electronic digital signage would proceed utilizing funds available. OCC would coordinate the completion of this work.

This resolution is also seeking to reallocate the FY 2002-03 CIP funds for the OCC. The OCC Director requested that CIP funds be used to fund the painting of wall covering for the existing building to match the interior walls of public spaces for the Expansion. The cost to paint the wall covering is \$100,981. Funding for the AV upgrade within the CIP Fund was reduced to provide funds for the wall covering work.

#### Fiscal Impact:

Change Order #4 does not increase the GMP with Hoffman Construction. The Project will be completed within the budgets identified under the base contract and Change Orders #1 through #3. Since Change Order #4 is a temporary transference of OCC Operating funds to the OCC Construction Fund, it has no financial impact to the overall Project budget. Change Order #4 is only a mechanism of transferring money subject to a negotiated recovery from the Design Team. The Project budget will remain at \$115.4 million.

#### **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends that the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission:

- Approve that Change Order #4 to MERC GMP contract 922771 with Hoffman Construction Company of Oregon for the Oregon Convention Center Expansion Project to adjust the work to be completed in the GMP contract, as defined in this Staff Report, with no increase to the GMP which will remain at \$103,171,481,and
- 2. That the MERC Commission approves the reallocation of \$100,981 within FY 2002-03 CIP funds to fund the painting of wall covering in the existing building, and
- 3. That the MERC Commission approves the reallocation and transfer of \$1,042,500.00 of OCC Operating funds to the OCC Construction Fund so as to finance the scope of work as defined in this Staff Report until the funds to complete the work are recovered from negotiations with the Design Team and the scope of work is adjusted to meet the funding available, and
- 4. That the MERC Commission further authorizes the MERC General Manager to execute Change Order #4 to the GMP contract on behalf of the Commission following established signature authority protocol.
