Dear Mr. Tarter,

I am writing in regard to Metro Solid Waste Facility Non-System License No. N-171-19A held by FCA US LLC - Mopar PDC to transport waste to Covanta Marion Inc. The license is currently scheduled to expire on June 30, 2021; however, you do not need to submit a renewal application to Metro at this time.

It is not yet necessary to submit an application because Covanta is seeking to become a designated facility of Metro's solid waste system. If Metro approves the request, then FCA US LLC - Mopar PDC would be able to transport waste to Covanta without the need to obtain a non-system license. I anticipate that the Metro Council will consider Covanta's request sometime in April. I'll follow-up with you when more information is available and let you know if you need to submit a renewal application.

Please continue to report monthly tonnage and remit the requisite regional system fee and excise tax as usual for all of the waste that FCA US LLC - Mopar PDC transports to Covanta in accordance with the non-system license.
