County Count:

Washington County currently has three, Tobias, Batchelor, Meek. Bauer and McClain will make the fourth.

Clackamas County has one, Urbigkeit and gets two more from its county and cities.

Multnomah County has three, Hennessee, Myers, Carnahan and will get at least two more from its cities and Knowles and Hansen. If the President of the Senate appoints Shoemaker and Rena appoints Ron Cease those two are also Multnomah County.
