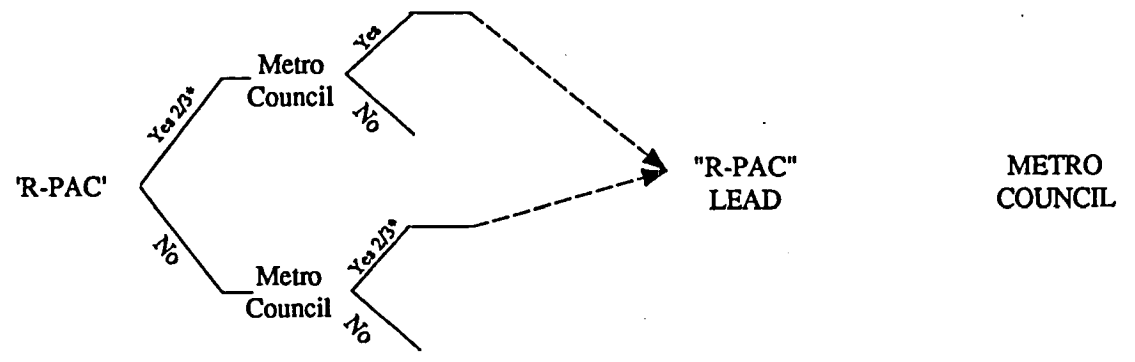

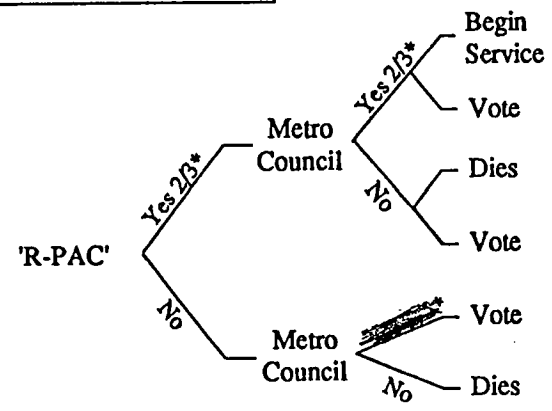

GENERAL PRINCIPLE FOR ALL OPTIONS: "Service delivery should be located closest to the people receiving the services unless there is a clearly documented advantage to having regional service delivery."
