## Consolidation effort topic of club meet

Henry Kane, a Beaverton attorney, will speak on "The Great Tax Grab—Metro's Consolidation Measure" at the Friday meeting of the Hillsboro Coffee Club.

The meeting will begin at 2 p.m. at the Hillsboro Methodist Church, Eighth Avenue and Lincoln Street. The public is invited.

Kane will discuss a ballot proposal from Metro—since taken off the ballot by a judge's ruling—that the three metropolitan counties (Washington, Clackamas and Multnomah), Metro and Tri-Met be consolidated into one regional agency.
