# METRO REGIONAL WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE OCTOBER 15, 2020 REGIONAL WORK PLAN FY 20-23 DEVELOPMENT

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#### Overview

In March 2019, Metro adopted the 2030 Regional Waste Plan which sets the policy direction for the region's garbage and recycling system. Responsibility for implementing the plan is shared by Metro and city and county governments in the region. Metro is responsible for coordinating implementation of the plan and assessing plan performance. Implementation of the goals and actions in the plan are shared between Metro and local governments. Some actions will be led by local government, some will be led by Metro and others with be co-led by both local government and Metro

To coordinate implementation of the plan, Metro and local governments will work together to create work plans every three years. A large number of the actions in the Regional Waste Plan represent guidance rather than requirements so timing for implementation will be determined by Metro and local governments. The actions selected for implementation for the first three years will be informed by required responsibilities, priorities set by Metro Council and local government and priorities identified in plan development by community members. The Regional Waste Advisory Committee will also provide input on timing of actions for implementation.


The Regional Waste Advisory Committee's role in this process is to review and provide input on the actions and activities that are prioritized for implementation in each three-year work plan.

# How will the work plan be developed?

The work plan will be collaboratively developed by Metro, cities, counties and community partners with input from the Regional Waste Advisory Committee. The work plan will identify:

- Actions for implementation in the first three years
- Roles for implementation
- High level resource allocations to inform annual budgeting
- Key implementation agreements to support accountability

The process will be broken into three major phases:

# **Phase 1: Identify Plan Actions**

The first phase of work will identify actions for implementation for the first three years. These actions will be identified based on required responsibilities, priorities set by Metro Council and local governments and priorities identified in plan development by community members. Metro, cities and counties will produce a draft list for consideration by the Regional Waste Advisory Committee. This phase will include a series of meetings with the committee to review the draft action list and an online survey to collect additional input.

#### Phase 2: Develop Work Plan FY 20-23

Phase 2 will develop the draft of the regional work plan that will include the list of actions, roles and high level resource allocations. To inform the work plan development, work groups will be convened to determine high-level activities, decision making agreements and resources necessary to implement specific actions. These work groups will include staff from Metro and local governments in addition to community based organizations that are co-developing and partnering on action implementation. Metro staff will provide the Regional Waste Advisory Committee with updates as this work progresses.

# **Phase 3: Finalize Implementation Agreements**

Phase 3 will develop agreements for implementation of the plan. This will include agreements between Metro, local government and community partners. These agreements will identify decision making processes, information sharing practices and scopes of work for funding allocations. This phase of the project will include a series of meetings with Metro, local governments and community organizations and an informational update to the Regional Waste Advisory Committee.

# How will the Regional Waste Committee be engaged in the work plan development?

The first phase of the project is to identify actions for implementation for the Regional Work Plan FY 20-23, including agency roles and responsibilities for action implementation. The role of the Regional Waste Advisory Committee during this phase of the project is to provide input on actions prioritized for the first three years and indicate which actions they would like to remain informed about during work plan implementation. Metro staff will return to the committee throughout the development of the work plan for continued guidance and to provide informational updates. The schedule of engagement with the Regional Waste Advisory Committee for the project is listed in Attachment A.

# **Regional Waste Advisory Committee Discussion**

Thinking about the next three years of the work plan, we'd like the committee's feedback on what was not included in the list and actions that you would like to see implemented in the short term or what was included that you think should be postponed, and why. Questions for consideration include:

- Which actions were not included that should be? Why?
- Which actions were included that should not be? Why?
- Which actions should the Regional Waste Advisory Committee have continued engagement?
