Dear Ms. Gehrke:

This letter confirms agreement between TriMet, SMART, and C-TRAN on distribution of the Federal FY2021 American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act funding, available to the Portland, OR-WA Urbanized Area.

ARP Act funding is specific to Section 5307 and Section 5310. Distribution of these funds, and the purpose of this split letter, is shown in the chart below and each agency will spend and report funds in accordance with respective requirements.
