## **Regional Trails and Greenways Plan**

Mel Huie of Metro's Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department led the group through several documents related to the Regional Trails and Greenways Plan for discussion and approval. A few changes were made to the *Glossary of Terms* and the *Criteria for Determining Regionally Significant Trails and Greenways* before they were unanimously approved (see attached for approved versions). The proposed additions of the North Willamette River Greenway Trail, the Willamette Trolley Shoreline Trail, the East Buttes Loop Trail and the Sullivan's Gulch/Banfield/I-84 Corridor Trail to the Regional Trails and Greenways Plan were all unanimously approved (see attached for more information). The group began discussion of the matrix of comments received about the Regional Trails and Greenways Map. This discussion will continue at the February meeting.
