> Exempt Status: The project is exempt from air quality and transportation demand modeling analysis per 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2 - Widening narrow pavements or reconstructing bridges (no additional travel lanes).

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification corrects the limits entry error on the last admin mod (type stating 296.00 versus 296.96. due to a mis-read of STIP Summary Report. The corrections are technical and do not represent a scope change. The total net change to the limits as described into he STIP Impacts Worksheet total 0.24 miles. Due to construction staging near the SW Barbur Ct. and SW 26th Ave, the intersection will be paved triggering ADA curb ramps. Bike lanes on SW Barbur Ct. to SW Barbur Blvd. are being added for connectivity to a City of Portland project on SW 26th Ave. The updated MP's resulted in an increase in MP of 0.24.
