<b>1:40 p.m.</b>	<b>Annual Daily Non-Motorized Traffic</b> <i>The region's vision for TSMO multimodal arterial performance includes collection bike volume data. Agencies have installed permanent bicycle and pedestrian count locations on regional trails, bridges, and at many other key locations. As part of <a href="#">BikePed Portal</a>, led by TREC at PSU, average annual daily non-motorized traffic (AADNT) is now estimated at these locations.
