4 Ordinances (First Reading and Public Hearing)

4.1 Ordinance No. 22-1476, For the Purpose of Annexing to the Metro District boundary approximately 8.16 acres located at 25190 SW Grahams Ferry Road, Wilsonville

Council President Peterson called on [Tim O'Brien]
[he/him], Metro
Principal Land Use Planner, to present to Council.

Tim described the scope of the ordinance and staff's
recommendation to Council.

Council Discussion:

Councilor Rosenthal asked if state law allows Metro to
annex land that is completely surrounded by its existing
boundaries. They also asked who would have jurisdiction
over the remaining corner parcel of land.

Metro Attorney Carrie MacLaren explained that the
annexation was initiated by the petition of a property
owner, and that she is happy to explain the legal process in
more detail at a later date.

Tim explained that the corner parcel is land that has yet to
be annexed by the City of Wilsonville or to the Metro
Boundary.

Seeing no further discussion on the topic, Council President
Peterson opened the meeting to members of the public
wanting to testify on Ordinance No. 22-1476.

Lee Leighton, from McKenzie, testified on behalf of the
applicant and made themselves available to Council if they
wished to ask any questions related to the annexation.
