Notes and Changes:

- > Exempt Status: The project is exempt from air quality and transportation demand modeling analysis per 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2 Safety Projects that correct, improve, or eliminate a hazardous location or feature
- > <u>Admin Mod Justification</u>: The overall scope of work remains focused on improved pedestrian access improvements in the same award area (Aloha district). The pedestrian improvements are considered exempt under 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2. The net cost also does not change. The net change in moving funds out of constrained years totals \$410,000 which equals a cost change of 16.4% against the net constrained year total cost. The added planning phase for project development work represents project refinement against the original award and does not represent a scope change. The project refinement stays true to the original RFFA award. The amendment actions being completed are considered administrative in nature and therefore allowable as an administrative modification.

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification transfer \$400k from PE to establish a planning phase for added pre-NEPA/Pre-Design project development activities. Project development activities will commence during FFY 2023 instead of PE. PE is bumped to FFY 2024. ROW and UR slip to FFY 2025. Construction remains in FFY 2026 for the time being. Upon RFFA award and verified during the kick-off meeting, Washington County advised Metro of adjustments in the planned pedestrian access improvements. This was due to the County completing some of the RFFA application site locations through other means (e.g. developer conditioned, etc.).

As a result, the project development phase will re-start the project and planned pedestrian access improvement locations. Since Washington County has used their own local funds to complete some of the initially proposed, Metro has agreed to complete a scope adjustment utilizing the project development planning phase. The net result is a panning phase is added to focused on the revised pedestrian access scope activities allowing the project to move forward into PE during FFY 2024. The project name and descriptions are simplified to reflect the revised scope area. Note: Once the project is ready t move forward into PE, the project description will be updated as required to address the final approve scope activities and site locations.

The overall scope of work as awarded under RFFA does not change. The number and location of the improvement locations will be refined through this action. The project's RFFA does not change. The ROW, UR, and construction phase awarded portion is moved out to FFY 2025 and 2026. As a four year document, the changes to the STIP will only reflect the PE, ROW, and UR phases. The 2021-24 STIP will show the project with only Planning (Project development) and PE programmed while the MTIP's six-year range will allow the entire project and funding to be shown.
