Detailed Description: The project will construct curb tight sidewalk on the north side of Jennings Avenue and bike lanes on both sides. The widening of the roadway to accommodate the bike lanes and sidewalk will require general excavation, rock excavation and new water quality and detention facilities, including new storm water collection infrastructure. The project will also require the removal and construction of a retaining wall and replacement of an existing guardrail.

STIP Description: Construct sidewalk on the north side of the road and bike lanes on both sides of the road to provide safe bicycle and pedestrian facilities to connect local residents with nearby schools, businesses and transportation options.

LAST Amendment or Admin Mod: Formal - September 2021 - SP21-02-SEP - PHASE SLIP AND COST INCREASE: The formal amendment addresses a PE and ROW phase funding shortfall by shifting STBG (and match) from the Construction phase to support the PE and ROW phases. The Construction phase is backfilled with local funds based on a phase of \$3,187,983.

Notes and Changes

> Exempt Status: The project is exempt from air quality and transportation demand modeling analysis per 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2 - .Air Quality - Bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification adds \$100k of STBG plus match to the PE phase. The net cost change to the project increases the cost by \$111,445 or 2.1%. Metro has authorized \$500k of STBG to be added to the project. The PE phase adjustment is needed as the phase has expended the current obligation. The remaining \$400k of STBG and match will be added to the Construction phase via an April admin mod once the current formal amendment containing the STBG authorized for the project completes its advancement to FFY 2022.

Additional Information:

PE phase increased by \$100,000. in Federal dollars of STBG (\$111,445.45 in total dollars). PE distribution: ODOT \$140,000. County \$1,061,345.45.(Total PE \$1,201,345.45)

CN phase increased by \$400,000. in Federal dollars of STBG (\$445,781.79 in total dollars). This funds replaces a portion of the Co.'s overmatch in the CN phase.

The total project cost estimate is \$5,389,352.45

The project cost increase is covered by the Metro STBG grant funds allocated to Clackamas County.
