In accordance with 23 CFR 450.328, Metro is submitting a Metro approved administrative modification bundle for ODOT review and approval for STIP inclusion. Key 22310 contains the Metro SFY 23 Master Agreement list of approved projects. The list is based on the approved SFY 23 UPWP. The SFY 23 UPWP has effectively completed a double formal/full amendment process which included:

- Two separate 30-day public notification opportunity to comment periods. (Note: The public review included the complete list of proposed SFY UPWP projects and their planning composition)
- Two separate reviews and public discussions at Metro's TPAC and IPACT committees
- Review and completion of a formal consultation process with ODOT, FHWA, an FTA

 Extensive project reviews to determine eligibility in the UPWP an specifically within the Master Agreement list of projects

Key 22310 functions as a UPWP project grouping bucket. The approved list of projects is included (called the Rosetta Stone) and is attached for reference wit this amendment bundle. Approved Metro STBG for the Master Agreement list of projects has been updated in Key 22310 along with PL, and 5303 funds. The added STBG originates from related UPWP buckets where the funds have been transferred to Key 22310. The adjustments to the other UPWP STBG funded buckets are included as part of the amendment as well.

A technical correction is occurring to Key 20880. There is no required action in the STIP. The project funds are already listed in FY 2022 in the STIP. They were pushed out in the MTIP to FFY 2025. Now that FTA has approved the TrAMS grant for Key 20880, the project and funds are being advanced back into FFY 2022 to reflect their actual obligation year.

Metro also understands that the PL and 5303 funding amounts are subject to change and a future amendment may be required to correct the funding levels.

I certify Metro has completed all required review and approval steps as the MPO and IAW with 23 CFR 450.328 for the 2021-24 MTIP for this administrative modification bundle. Detailed Description: Key 21839 22310 will be used to combine SFY allocated 5303 and STBG in Key 22151 and possible other planning keys dedicated to UPWP activities in SFY 2023 (FFY 2022). The Combination amendment for SFY 23 UPWP should occur around March 2022. Key 21839 22310 will become the final approval "Key" for the SFY 23 UPWP Master Agreement list of projects to be obligated by the end of June 2022. The UPWP MA project list are recurring annual planning projects Metro must complete by CFR requirements and unique 1-year Metro led/non-consultant driven projects. Inclusion of specific projects are through the annual UPWP process.

STIP Description: Portland Metro MPO planning funds for state fiscal year 2023 (federal fiscal year 2022). Projects will be selected and support the annual Metro Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

LAST Amendment or Admin Mod: Foral - January 2022 - COMBINE FUNDS: JA22-07-JAN2 - Combine STBG funds from Keys 20877 and 22151 for Key 22310 to act as the SFY 23 UPWP Master Agreement key.

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification updates the PL, 5303, STBG, and local funds to reflect the authroized funding insupport of the SFY 2023 Master Agreement list of Projects. Development of Metro's annual UPWP consistes of a multi-month development and review process. The review process includes two separate 30-day public notification comment periods, nultiple public reviews by TPAC and JPACT committees, and a formal consultation with FHWA, FTA, and ODOT. The UPWP contains a funding summary list of projects and their proposed funding. The projects and funding are included as part of the public review process. The formal amendment submisison requirements have been completed through the extensive UPWP development and review process.

Those projects which are not required to be stand-alone projects in the MTIP (requirung a seprate IGA, or possess unique funding which may proceed through FTA TrAMS system or FHWA's FMIS process as astand-alone project) are combined together into a single MTIP project Key known as the "Master Agreement" list of approved UPWP projects. The Metro SFY UPW Master Agreementproject Key is 22310 and includes PL, 5303, STBG-U, State STBG, and local overmatch. Salem and Metro work throuh the apporved PL and 5303 amounts which also now incudes de-obligated carry-over from a prior year. Supplementing the Master Agreement involves adding Metro STBG. Starting in January, UPWP revenue buckets (e.g TSMO, Next corridor Planning, and others) contribute to the annual STBG needs. As part of the updates to Key 22310, the amendment contains the fund transfers from these projects. The increase to Key 22310 is a little misleading due to the split and transfers fro ther approved UPWP buckets. The addition of the local overmatching funds comprises the bulk of the new additional funds.

The basic composition of each fund type for inclusion in Key 22310 is shown below:

- PL = \$621,146 of authorized de-obligated carry-over from the prior year + \$1,550,912 of new annual PL = a totalof \$2,172,058
- 5303 = \$421,349 of authorized carryover from the prior year + \$630.217 of new annual 5303 = a total of \$1,051,566
- UPWP Metro STBG-U: Key 22310 Starting STBG = \$1,554,953 + \$528,930 from Key 20888 + \$74,263 from Key 22145 + \$138,128 from Key 22169 Total Metro STBG is \$2,296,274
- State STBG = \$201,893 of State STBG (Z240) and match for a total of \$225,000
- Local overmatching funds = \$4,487,944
- Total all funds = \$10,864,620

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification advances the STBG-U and match from FFY 2025 to FFY 2022 in the MTIP. There is no action needed in the STIP as STIP was not updated when Metro pushed out the project to FFY 2025. The project funding was not initially thought needed in FFY 2022. However, Metro Finance moved forward with FTA to flex transfer the funds for the RTO. However, they did not tell the MTIP section. The MTIP ended up reflecting the project in FFY 2025 as a result. By the time the error was discovered, FTA already had approved the TrAMS grant.

As a technical correction, Key 20880 is being advanced back into FFY 2022 in the MTIP to reflect that is has completed the flex transfer and is now considered obligated. No action in the STIP is required. **The FTA TrAMS FAIN grant number for the Key 20880 is 1711-2022-1.**

Metro is now correcting the mistake in the MTIP and STIP by advancing Key 20880 to FFY 2022. We also understand that a new Key most likely will have to assigned to the project. On the positive side, Metro can credit an additional \$1.6 million of STBG-U obligated during FFY 2022towards our targets.
