#### LOCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT State Funded Local Project

Project Name: Pedestrian & Bike improvements (Beaverton)

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the **STATE OF OREGON**, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "State" or "ODOT;" and **CITY OF BEAVERTON**, acting by and through its elected officials, hereinafter referred to as "Agency," both herein referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties."

Agency/State Agreement No. 34873 / 73000-00004565

#### TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 1. State and Agency agree to Agency constructing and delivering Pedestrian & Bike improvements (Beaverton), hereinafter referred to as "Project." The Project includes the construction and installation of lighting, traffic signal modifications, green conflict markings, and advance warning signs to improve safety for pedestrians and bicycle riders. The Project location and approximate limits are shown in "Exhibit A," attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. The total Project cost for the work to be performed under this Agreement is estimated at \$750,158.00, which is subject to change. Prior to exchanging funds, the federal share of the total Project cost is \$691,795.71.
  - a. Per the 1:1 fund exchange ratio of state dollars to federal dollars, Agency exchanges \$691,795.71 of the federal dollars allocated for this Project for \$691,795.71 in state dollars.
  - b. State funds under this Agreement are limited to \$691,795.71.
- 3. Upon receipt and approval of Agency's invoice(s), State shall proportionately reimburse to Agency for 92.22% of eligible, actual costs incurred in carrying out the Project, up to the maximum amount of state funds committed for the Project in Paragraph 2.b above.
