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Key Note: For Key 22180, TriMet Bus and Rail Preventive Maintenance (2022), the UZA funding adjustment exceeds the FTA 30% cost change threshold. Metro has waived the threshold limitation due to TriMet's need to obligate the approved funding before the end of FFY 2022. Metro requests ODOT complete a two week public notification period for the project and allow the project to continue within the July #1 Administrative Modification Bundle.

Keys 22164, 22181, and 22184 includes required UZA funding updates which exceed the 30% threshold, and are in FFY 2023. The required project updates will occur as part of the September Formal Amendment.

I certify Metro has completed all required review and approval steps as the MPO and IAW with 23 CFR 450.328 for the 2021-24 MTIP for this administrative modification bundle. Detailed Description: Keys 18837 and 22132 are combined for construction delivery efficiencies. The project is located on Columbia Blvd between Alderwood and Cully in NE Portland. The project is a safety improvement that will install new signal at Columbia/Alderwood, complete minor widening on Columbia from Alderwood to Cully to add a new right turn lane, add sidewalks and bike lanes, add a new signal at the Columbia/Cully intersection, plus provide intersection improvements including sidewalks and bike lanes (22-24 RFFA awarded project).

STIP Description: Install or replace a signal and construct a taper on Columbia Blvd's east leg at Alderwood for future side-by-side left-turn lanes between Cully and Alderwood. Construct sidewalks at the Columbia/Alderwood intersection and on N side to Cully. The project will keep Columbia Blvd a viable freight route while enhancing neighborhood connections and improving safety.

LAST Amendment or Admin Mod: Administrative - May 2021 - AB21-15-MAY1 - COMBINED PROJECT Key 22132 is combined into 18837 for increased delivery efficiencies. PE is already obligated under Key 18837. Key 22132 was a follow-on later Metro RFFA award supporting Cully/Columbia improvements

Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification adds \$739,737 of new funds approved to the project in support of ROW phase cost needs. The admin mod also slips the ROW phase to FFY 2023. Fund approval via OTC approval that provided an extra \$95 million to the ADA program. OTC approval was made last March 2022.OTC staff item on file at Metro. The added funds are addressing various inflationary cost increases the ADA projects are now experiencing. The cost increase to the project represents a 8.87% change and is under the 20% threshold.
