### **Notes and Changes**

> Exempt Status: The project is exempt from air quality and transportation demand modeling analysis per 40 CFR 93.126, Table 2 - Air Quality - Bicycle and pedestrian facilities

### Reason for Modification and Summary of Changes plus Impacts:

The Administrative Modification advances the ROW phase forward to FFY 2023 to obligate before the end of FFY 2022, increases the ROW phase cost by drawing STBG from Cons and backfilling the difference with local funds. Reference Mark Hardeman's 8/15/2022 email requesting the changes. The cost increase to \$8,160,115 represents 5.4% increase which is less than the 20% threshold.
