Gentlemen:

We completed the projects in reference to subject permits by September 1982, but, unfortunately, we failed to send you the completion report attached to our permit. We are doing so now, as well as apprising you of the current status.

During the winter and spring of 1982-1983 the revetment was eroded by high water. It was repaired in September of 1983. After repairs, the revetment was armored with a filtration blanket of 5" minus rock and covered with class 2 rip rap to prevent further erosion. An overflow spillway approximately one foot lower than the revetment was constructed and armored to prevent future erosion to the revetment during spring high water runoff.
