We are faxing in its entirety the USF&W assessment of the current status and the outstanding elements of the Rivergate Agreement. We think the format and organization of the document is excellent and will probably use it as a model for future mitigation site reviews. As discussed in our earlier letter elements outside the original agreement are not on the table. It is our understanding that the results of the agency meeting agreed with this position.
