Dear Mr. Bowes:

The Port requests permission to install a sixty (60) inch corrugated culvert pipe at the east end of the north arm of the Columbia Slough for the purpose of controlling the flow of water from Smith Lake.

It is understood that the city owns the land where a small dam with a culvert is now located being generally at the northwesterly end of Smith Lake. This area we believe is identified as being Tax Lot 2 in Section 31, 2 N, 1 E, in Multnomah County. Attached is a plat of the Columbia Slough area showing the location of the dam at lower right corner. If an approval is granted, the Port will raise the height of the dam and install the large culvert designed to act as a spillway gate control. This work is hoped to be accomplished before the rainy season comes on.
