Elaine,

In searching documentation for the permit, it states:
3.2.1.1. US Fish and Wildlife Service. The USFWS is the lead Federal agency for this project. The project received funding from USFWS, USFS (through a grant to Ducks Unlimited), Columbia Land Trust, and Metro. The USFWS completed ESA/MSA consultation with NOAA Fisheries (discussed in greater detail in Section 4.3, below). Additionally, the USFWS provided a response to the public notice that no action [or comment] will be taken at the present time because of limited funding and staff within the USFWS [under the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act]. So perhaps that is why the permit requests you to send reports to USFWS (I've included a local address). Please send the report to the person you've been working with, and let me know when that has been done and I will document it in the file.

As far as authorization to use the proposed fish basket, I recommend you submit a drawing and describe the use of the basket, and the timing, to Corps Multnomah County Regulator John Barco. Since you are working with the fish agencies, processing should not be a problem on the fish side; in fact, they may provide the information for you to send to us.
