**17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE**

From downtown Portland, take US 30 west towards St. Helens. After about 14 miles, make a right turn onto a dirt access road located on the east side of US 30, across the highway from NW Boat Basin Road and a parking area. Access to the project site is gated / locked, so please coordinate with Metro prior to visiting the project site.

**18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)**

The proposed project would implement maintenance and safety improvements at an existing water control structure on Multnomah Channel (i.e., the north site). Project components include construction of a new walkway on top of the existing structure; installation of a stem and bevel gear operator to facilitate operation of the tide gates; and installation of a new trash rack on the outlet (Multnomah Channel) side of the structure. All proposed work would occur within the footprint of the existing structure with the exception of four new pre-cast concrete footing blocks which would be placed below the OHWM on the outlet side of the structure to support the new walkway. Each new footing block would be 2-feet wide by 2-feet deep by 6-feet long, and would sit on 2-feet of compacted base rock.

**19. Project Purpose (Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions)**

The purpose of the project is to improve the ability for Metro staff to safely access, maintain and operate an existing water control structure and tide gate on Multnomah Channel. The current configuration of the structure requires heavy equipment to manipulate the tide gates, which can be dangerous depending on weather conditions. In addition, there is no formal walkway or safety devices (e.g., handrails) to allow staff to safely work on or around the structure. Finally, the current trash rack is improperly sized to prevent debris from accumulating on the outlet side of the structure.

**20. Reason(s) for Discharge**

Up to 7.2 CY of pre-cast concrete and rock would be placed in Multnomah Channel to create the footing blocks for the new accessway. All other work would occur within the footprint of the existing structure and would not require placement of additional fill material below the OHWM. The structure is located in a navigable waterway regulated under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act.
