Description:

The Intern will develop and coordinate a citizen monitoring program of bird and wildlife populations at Smith and Bybee Lakes Wildlife Area, a 2000-acre wetland near the confluence of the Willamette and Columbia Rivers. The goal of the monitoring program is to collect information on patterns of seasonal use of the Lakes by different wildlife species in different habitats and conditions, using local citizen volunteers.

Tasks:

The Intern will be responsible for overall coordination of the project, including volunteer recruitment and coordination, managing the database of collected observations, and providing updates to volunteers.

Qualifications:

Ability to work independently
Experience working with volunteers
Experience with databases and data analysis
General knowledge of natural history / wetlands ecology
Bird and wildlife identification skills helpful
