attached is a summary chronology of the St Johns Neighborhood Ass'n flap. My additions and comments:

- 1. We made a clerical error not keeping up Keepes' notice when we moved to e-mail. There is no way to "redo" that error, which Michael Jordan, myself and my staff have personally apologized to Keepes for.
- 2. The meetings took place and the committee has rejected Keepes's motion to set aside all action taken in his absence. There is no legal reqmt I am aware of that requires the committee to do as Keepes asks. Also note that the meetings have been held at same time and place for about 8 years and Keepes attended relatively few when he was getting notice.
- 3. I called Mr Keepes and spoke to him at some length in early June just when he got Jordan's letter. (Elaine, please get Rex a copy of that letter). I calmly asked him what relief he wanted at this point (were there specific actions taken by the committee he wanted reopened?). I got back only a demand that Patricia Sullivan be fired, which I told him was not going to happen, and then I got a long angry speech about the U.S. Constitution, due process (?), lawsuits, etc. I listened, said very little, reiterated the apology and the fact it would not happen again. I let him know I had asked the Committee to give him time to discuss and perhaps reconsider any specific action taken in meetings he got no notice of (he had all minutes etc. by that time). The committee did give him time at its June 24 meeting but the conversation wasn't productive; please see summary.
- 4. I don't know what more we can do at this point. The committee seems fine and in the end this is a committee issue not just Metro.
- 5. I do not believe we have much if any legal exposure here. JD

# Dennis Keepes/SJNA Chronology

- May 16, Stewart received phone call from Dennis Keepes, notifying her that he had not received notices of SBMC meetings since November. He had received only two notices, both had been sent to him by committee members responsible for the activities. Stewart apologized; summarized committee activities and actions that had occurred since November; assured Keepes that he would receive a full package of all meeting notes, correspondence and other materials immediately; and stated that this omission would not happen again. Keepes requested the issue be placed on the SBMC agenda for the May 27 meeting.
- May 16 Sullivan mailed a complete packet to Keepes, with a written apology from her. Stewart and Sullivan deduced that Keepes had indeed not received any materials distributed by Sullivan because she had been providing them to an email list of SBMC members; Keepes did not have email and was consistently overlooked because his mailing label was on a different page than the other recipients of hard-copy materials.
- May 16 Full packet of SBMC materials also sent to SJNA chair Robin Plance.
- May 27 Keepes attended SBMC meeting and submitted a written "grievance" and request for a remedy to the chair. At the meeting, he verbally requested a hearing in front of the Metro Council and a specific remedy, that all business conducted by the SBMC from November 2002 until the present meeting be voided.
- May 28 Stewart forwarded Keepes' grievance to Jordan, Cooper and Desmond.
- May 28 Cooper voice mail to Desmond reminding staff to comply with public meetings law, including sending meeting notices to whomever requests them.
- May 30 Jordan received letter from Keepes confirming procedures he was told by phone (Keepes had spoken with someone on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor; I do not know who).
- June 1 Keepes letter to SBMC chair and Metro, noting that he requested the issue be placed on the agenda for the next SJNA general meeting.
- June 6 Jordan letter to Keepes, expressing regret for oversight and advising him that Metro will not ask SBMC to set aside any actions it took in his absence.
- June 16 Keepes letter to SBMC chair and Metro, notifying of the SJNA vote to "pursue our right to lawful notice".
- June 17 Keepes voice mail to Stewart, stating he cannot find the SBMC "charter". Stewart returned call, informed him there was no charter, and mailed a copy of the management plan to him.
- June 24 SBMC meeting provided time on the agenda for Keepes' questions and/or

comments regarding actions taken during his absence. Keepes submitted 3 memos to SBMC: 1) modification to meeting notes to state "The paragraph...is not true...", 2) motion to go to executive session [not seconded], 3) "appeal" of the June 6 letter from Jordan. He gave a 4<sup>th</sup> memo to the chair after the meeting had ended, requesting references to all SBMC actions during the course of his grievance [he had already received all material that Stewart could compile for him in the May 16 mailing].

- June 27 Bragdon, Burkholder and Stacey received phone calls from Keepes regarding the issue. Burkholder informed Keepes that he felt the response from Jordan et al. was reasonable and sufficient. [I do not know the response from Bragdon.]
- Early July Stewart and Sullivan discussed notification; both seasonal representatives from SJNA (Keepes in winter, Piltz in summer) will receive all packets year-round.
- July 22 SBMC meeting Ray Piltz represented SJNA; Keepes was not present. Piltz did not raise issue of notification.
