2. <u>Consideration of a Request from Councilor Bonner to Transfer</u> Funds From His Per Diem Account to His Expense Account

Chairman Gardner reported Councilor Bonner had made the request in order to pay for publishing and mailing a newsletter to his constituents. The Council's rules allowed for such a transfer.

Motion: Councilor DeJardin moved to approve the transfer and Councilor Collier seconded the motion.
