Acting Chair Dave Phillips called the meeting to order at 4:10 p.m.

<u>1. Any New Legislation</u>

Those present discussed various pieces of legislation which could or could not affect plastics and recycling thereof. The group discussed Senate Bill 3444. Acting Chair Phillips said there were several other bills similar to it.

2. <u>Review Presentation to Metro Legislative Task Force and Council Solid</u> <u>Waste Committee</u>

Those present discussed testimony given to the Metro Legislative Task Force and the Council Solid Waste Committee at their joint meeting March 17, 1989. <u>Ray Barker</u> noted a majority of members from either committee did not attend. <u>Jeff Gage</u> said all testimony was given by representatives from the Plastics Recycling Task Force (PRTF) except for a letter submitted by Jeanne Roy, Recycling Advocates. He said no action was taken.

Acting Chair Phillips requested Senate Bill 424 be placed on the April 10, 1989, PRTF agenda for discussion purposes.

3. Policy Statement Development

Acting Chair Phillips said Chair Kirkpatrick wanted a statement of principle which would help bills facilitate plastics recycling as opposed to banning and would be couched in general terms to guide groups through any bill as it appeared. Mr. Gage said the Metro Legislative Task Force recommended such a statement also.

Those present discussed such a policy statement further. Individual statements were assigned to a PRTF member for further development and presentation at the next meeting.

Acting Chair Phillips adjourned the meeting at 4:45 p.m.
