2. <u>Resolution No. 90-1221, Approving a Contract for</u> <u>Construction of the Africa Rain Forest Exhibit at the Metro</u> <u>Washington Park Zoo</u>

Kay Rich, Assistant Zoo Director, presented the report to the Committee and introduced Bob Porter, Metro Washington Park Zoo Construction Coordinator. Mr. Rich said the low bidder was L.D. Mattson, Inc. at \$3,950,000. The bidder had complied with all the bid requirements and exceeded Metro's DBE/WBE goals. He noted the only other bid received was from Bishop Contractors, Inc. who was currently doing work at the Zoo. Mr. Rich told the Committee there would be funds in the next fiscal year's budget to complete the project. Councilor Knowles asked Mr. Rich if he had any concerns about changing contractors. Mr. Rich said L.D. Mattson, Inc. had been thoroughly checked and he was comfortable with the choice.

- <u>Motion</u>: Councilor Knowles moved to recommend Council adoption of Resolution No. 90-1221.
- <u>Vote</u>: Councilors Gardner, Knowles and Ragsdale voted aye.

The motion carried unanimously.
