The Living Water Garden is in Cheng Du, China, on the Fu-Nan River. It is used as a symbol of how a river can be cleaned up while turning it into art.




What was the inspiration?

What Happens at the Cheng Du Water Garden?

The Cheng Du water garden uses a system of constructed wetlands, flow forms, and art to illustrate natural methods for cleaning water.



How Does it Work?

Water from the river is fed into man made ponds containing different native plants that pull toxins out of the water.



This garden provides an opportunity for people to witness the cleaning of their river, and ways to interact with the water.
