
Combined Sewer Overflows

Portland's Clean River Plan

- Aggressively control combined sewage overflows.
- •Plant trees, native vegetation, and create buffers along streams.
- •Reduce storm water flow and pollutants reaching our streams
- Upgrade Portland's eastside sewer system
- •Control erosion from construction development
- •Increase pollution and prevention source control.
- Education and stewardship
- Floodplain restoration
- Watershed assessment and monitoring
