1:40 p.m. San José's use of Camera-derived Data

Using existing traffic cameras, the City of San José added an edge-computing system to pilot advanced data collection and support the City's collision review process. With a protocol in place (attached), the system allows City engineers to assess safety metrics and conditions before and after safety counter measures are implemented. Traffic violations, near misses, turning movements, counts and delay are collected. The presentation will be led by Ho Nguyen, ITS Manager for the City of San José, and Alex Colosivschi, CEO Currux Vision. TransPort will hear considerations for the pilot, early results and lessons
