In accordance with 23 CFR 450.328, Metro is submitting a Metro approved administrative modification bundle for ODOT review and approval for STIP inclusion. The May #2 Administrative Modification is under Metro amendment number AM23-15-MAY2 and contains four projects specifically related to the SFY 2024 UPWP Master Agreement and related to UPWP set-aside funds.

#### Added notes:

- 1. Final PL, 5303, Metro STBG, State STBG, and local overmatch updates in Key 22311 have occurred per the approved Metro SFY 2024 UPWP budget table. Required reviews and approvals between Metro Finance and ODOT Finance also have occurred resulting in the final programming amounts for Key 22311.
- 2. Key 22311 represents the required funding in support of the SFY 2024 UPWP Mater Agreement list of approved projects. A copy of the approved project listing, referred to as the UPWP Rosetta Stone is included for proof-of-funding and fiscal constraint.
- 3. Metro added STBG to Key 22311 originates from two Key transfers: All STBG-U from Key 22598 and \$112,008 from Key 22154.

- 4. The short description includes reference to the approved legislation for the funding. Assuming the TIP is maintaining the same information in the comment section, no action to the STIP is required. This is an MTIP technical update.
- 5. Key 22312 receives a minor increase of PL funds. I believe these funds are in support of the eTIP development but can't be obligated and expended until FFY 2024 (post October 2024). For accounting and tracking purposes, Metro needs to show the funds as part of the SFY 2025 UPWP in FFY 2024.

I certify Metro has completed all required review and approval steps as the MPO and IAW with 23 CFR 450.328 for the 2021-24 MTIP for this administrative modification bundle. PL and 5303 funds are adjusted based on revised approved funding allocations.

**STIP Description:** Portland Metro MPO planning funds for state fiscal year 2024 (federal fiscal year 2023). Projects will be selected and support the annual Metro Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

LAST Amendment or Admin Mod: Formal Amendment, January 2023 - Update PL and 5303 plus add preliminary STBG for SFY 2024 UPWP. This is a funding positioning amendment with the final change to occur in April based on the final draft UPWP.

The local overmatch as part of the Master Agreement is being added there through this administrative modification.

Modification #1 Summary	Modification #1 to Key 22311 represents the removal of \$53,532 of PL (plus match - \$59,659 total) from the prior submission. The PL will be committed to Key 22674 in support of the eTIP development. The PL has also been split into two fund codes: Z4530 and Y410. The MTIP will show the PL as a total (\$2,550,617) while the STIP will split the pL into the two separate funding

pots of Z450 and Y410. The net chnage to the project is a cost decrease from the inital prgrammed amount of \$11,054,200 to \$10,994,542.
