4. Chief Operating Officer Communication

Marissa Madrigal provided an update on the following events or items:

Councilor Lewis mentioned that Expo Futures sport committee met and that the discussion was well received as they spoke about where they need to be in terms of being a tourism destination.

Councilor Rosenthal spoke about being in communication about the progress on Cooper Mountain Nature Reserve and mentioned he would be happy to discuss further with other councilors.
