I applaud your willingness to look at the bigger picture not only on this issue, but all the others that we will face as we fight for our fair share of the region's resources. Your support has given me some room from which to work on behalf of the four east county cities.

We have agreement from all four cities in East Multnomah County on the basic contents of the resolution. I am now setting up meetings with the Multnomah County Commissioners next week for the following purpose:

1. To show our support for regional facilities.
2. To educate them on the unfairness of the current direction of the intergovernmental agreement (IGA) in making other cities pay for another city's facility.
3. To press the resolve shown by the East County cities that they are not willing to stand by and pay for a City of Portland facility to the detriment of their own citizens.

4. To impress upon them and others, the ill will that is being generated by the proposal in its current form, and the escalation of that ill will should they attempt to pass the tax without the modifications as outlined in Resolution No. 99-2871.

I would ask you to send me a letter of support, as mayor, of Resolution No. 99-2871. I know this is all I can request, as you have not taken a formal position via your council. Having a letter from the mayor of each of the four cities in East Multnomah County will strengthen our position with the Multnomah County Commissioners. This will also help when a final vote is taken at Metro.

Re: Hotel/Motel and Vehicle Rental Tax

The City of Gresham has long been a creative participant with Metro and Multnomah County in beneficial legislation, and has supported many regional endeavors. In this case, however, the latest funding proposal for the expansion of various regional facilities is grossly unfair to the east Multnomah County hospitality and tourism industry, specifically.

We have many concerns about the following issues:

- The hotels, motels and vehicle rentals in east Multnomah County would be contributing additional taxes to fund these facilities, while deriving little, if any, direct business benefit. While it is true that the residents of the region benefit from having facilities such as Civic Stadium or the Performing Arts Center nearby, the business benefits decrease dramatically the further a business lies from that regional facility.
- The 3% already collected by Multnomah County is used to help fund the Portland Area Visitors Association (POVA) and the Oregon Convention Center. The hotels, motels and vehicle rentals of east Multnomah County are already contributing their fair share, given the lesser benefit they receive from these facilities.
- The \$6.2 million needed to fund the proposed facility renovations will be secured through a bond issue. However, in the first year alone the Hotel/Motel and Vehicle Rental Tax (HM-Vehicle tax) will collect \$450,000 in excess of what is needed to pay the bond issue. Of that \$450,000, the four East County cities will generate \$340,000.
- Regional facilities, such as the Oregon Convention Center, should be supported by the whole region. As it is set up now, the HM-Vehicle tax is being assessed to Multnomah County only. Neither Washington or Clackamas county are being taxed this way, yet they also benefit from "access" to regional facilities.

- The City of Gresham and all of east Multnomah County have significant unmet hospitality and tourism needs. For instance, this area would derive great benefit from a Conference Center for small groups.
- We would expect that you would honor the Multnomah County transient lodging tax set out in code section 11.400 - 11.499, specifically 11.419, Credit Against City Tax, which reads as follows:

Any person subject to the payment or collection of a tax under this subchapter is entitled to a credit against the payment of the tax in the amount due any city within the county for a transient lodgings tax for the same occupancy.

We request that you distribute the revenues generated in east Multnomah County from the 2.5% tax increase proposal, to their respective cities. This would go a long way toward funding some of the unmet hospitality and tourism needs of east Multnomah County, enhancing the region as a "destination" area.

In conclusion, we are also very concerned about being taxed without City representation. This is not a fair or equitable way to fund improvements, renovations or expansion of regional facilities. I'm anticipating your response to these issues.
